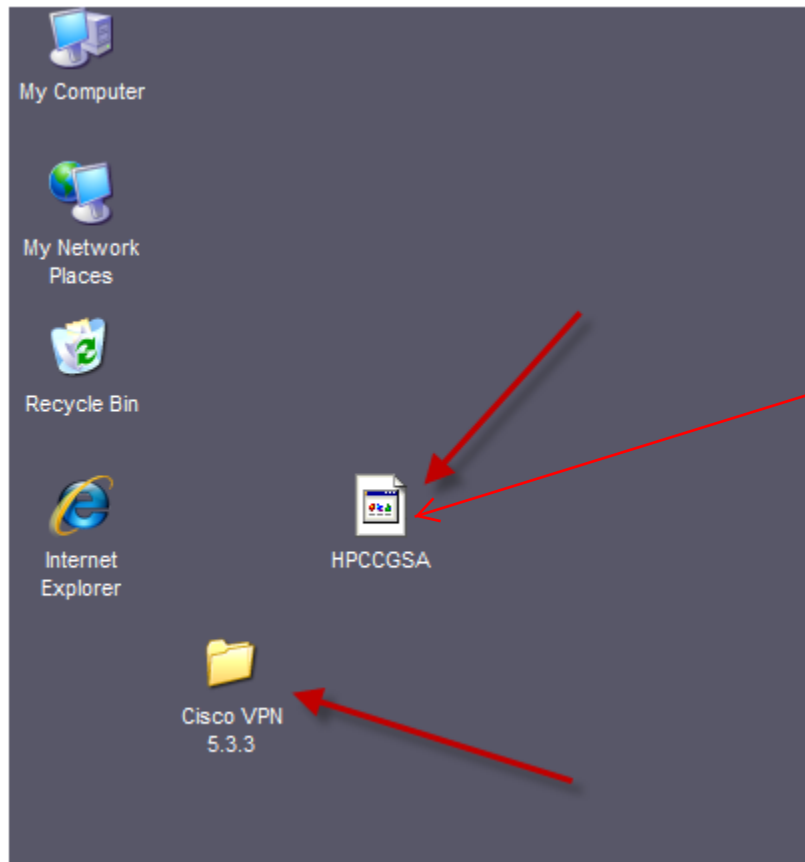




NOTE 1: A few Companies enforce and deploy a high level Domain Policy to their clients computers therefore you will need to contact your network administrator to help you load the Cisco VPN client onto your computer.

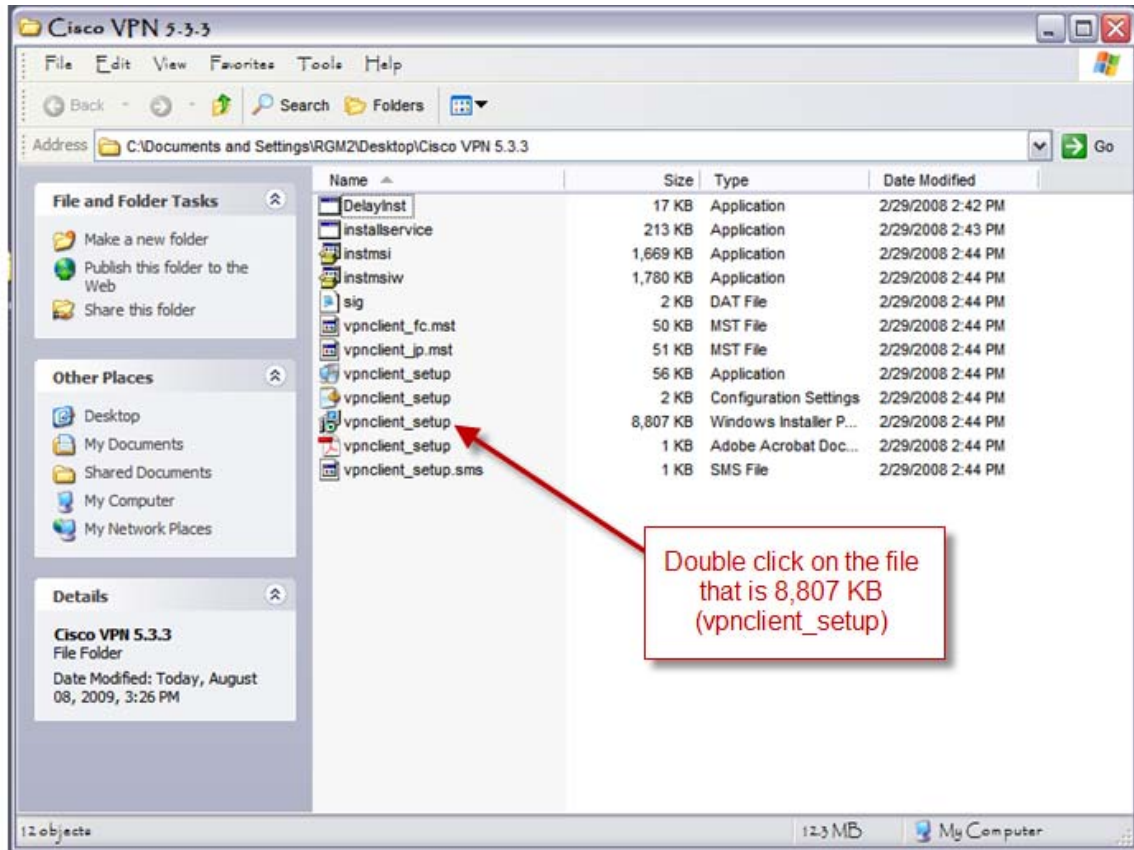
NOTE 2: Unfortunately there is something out of our control. Cisco does not allow 64bit VPN connections. All 32bit systems (either Windows XP or Windows Vista) will work with these installation instructions. Cisco anticipates there will be a 64bit VPN available in early 2010.

1. First download the Cisco VPN 5.3.3.rar file from the <http://newcourthousesandiego.com/vpn.aspx> website. Save this file to your desktop and extract the file using WinRAR.
2. Two files will appear. A folder for the Cisco VPN 5.3.3 installer and the HPCCGSA.pcf file you will need to import the VPN settings to your computer.





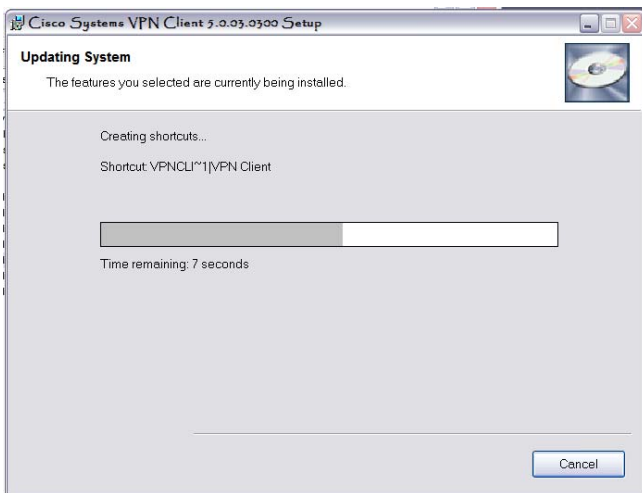
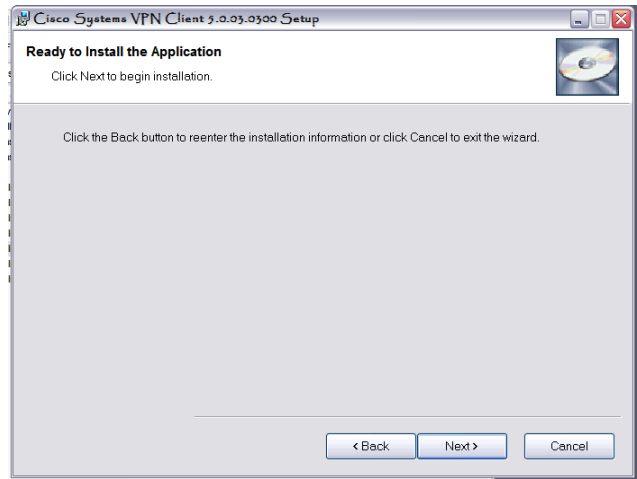
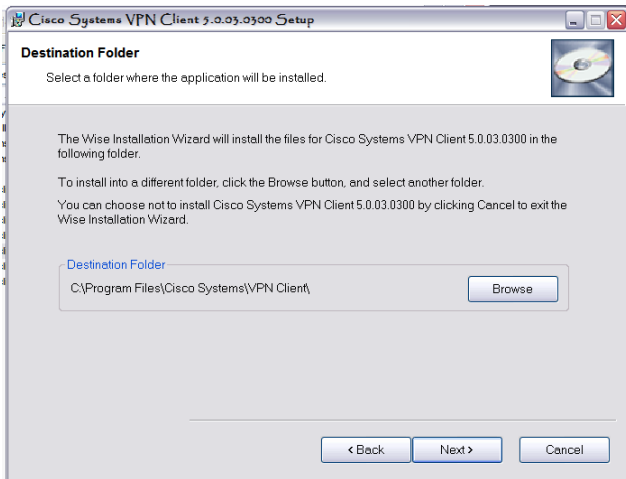
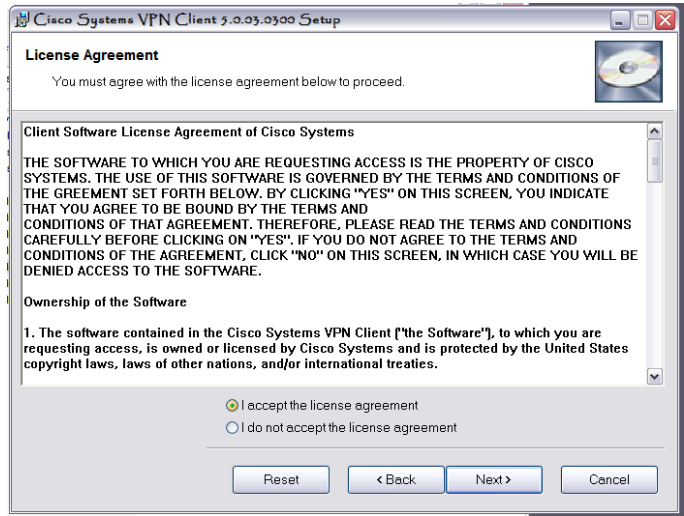
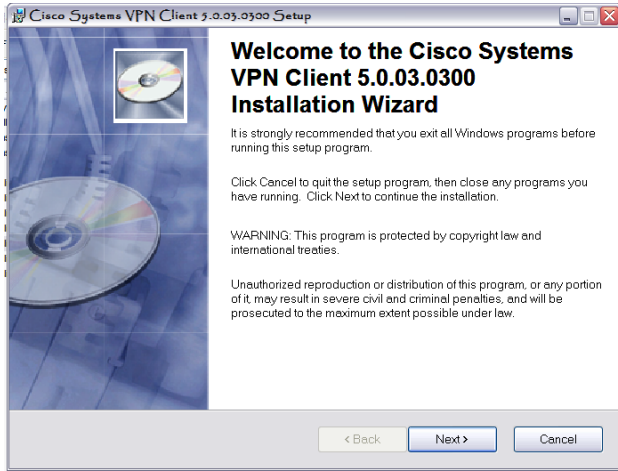
3. Open the Cisco VPN 5.3.3 folder and you will see 12 files. Please double click on the vpn.client_setup file that is 8,807 KB.

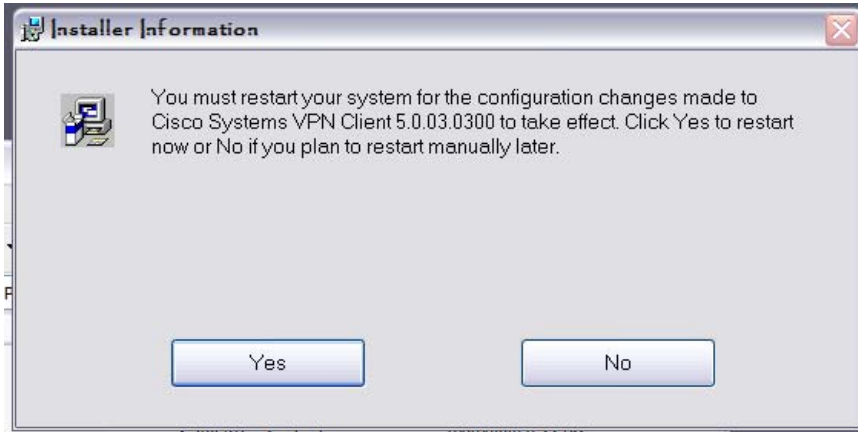


4. Next you will see a series of installation steps. Please click Next to all of them to install the Cisco VPN 5.3.3.



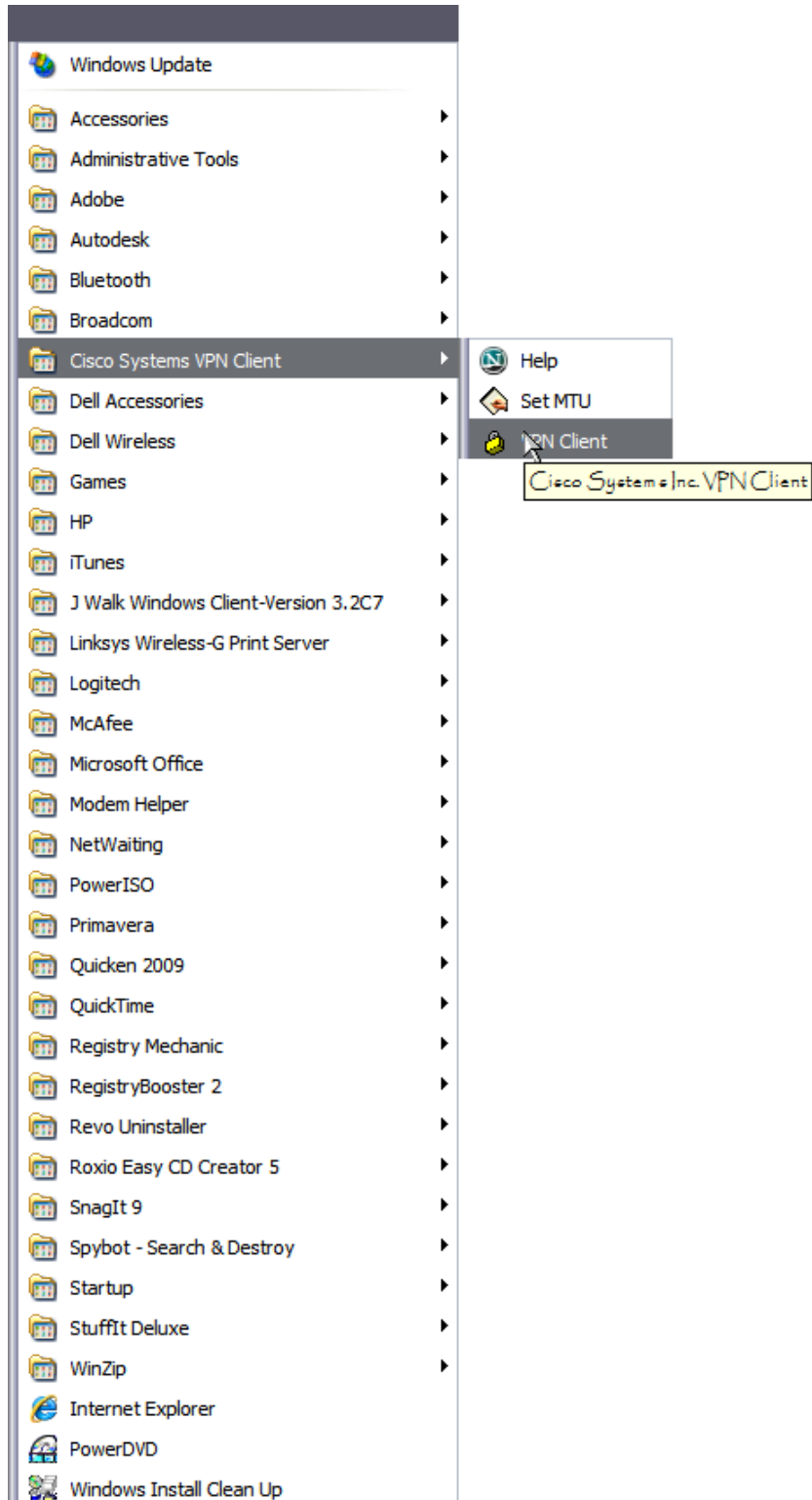


5. After you have installed the Cisco VPN 5.3.3 software, you will need to restart your computer.



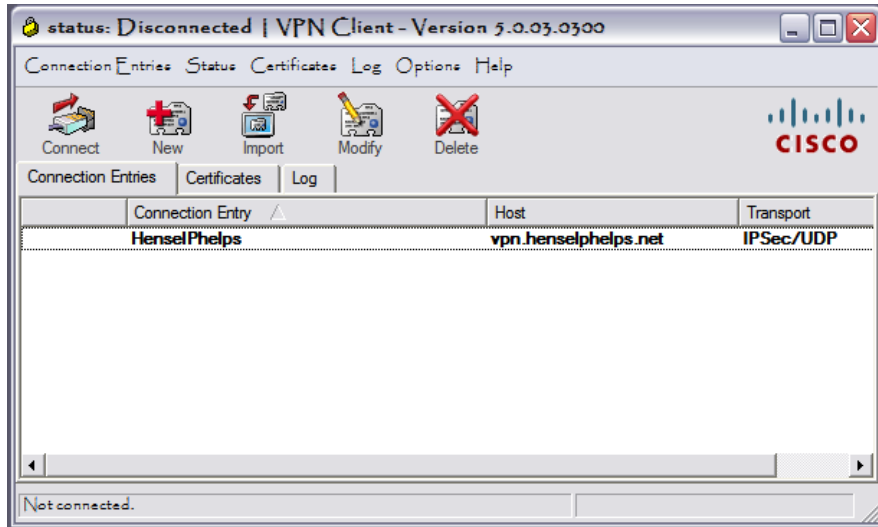


6. Then you will need to go to your **Start Menu/All Programs/Cisco Systems VPN Client** and click on the VPN Client Shortcut.

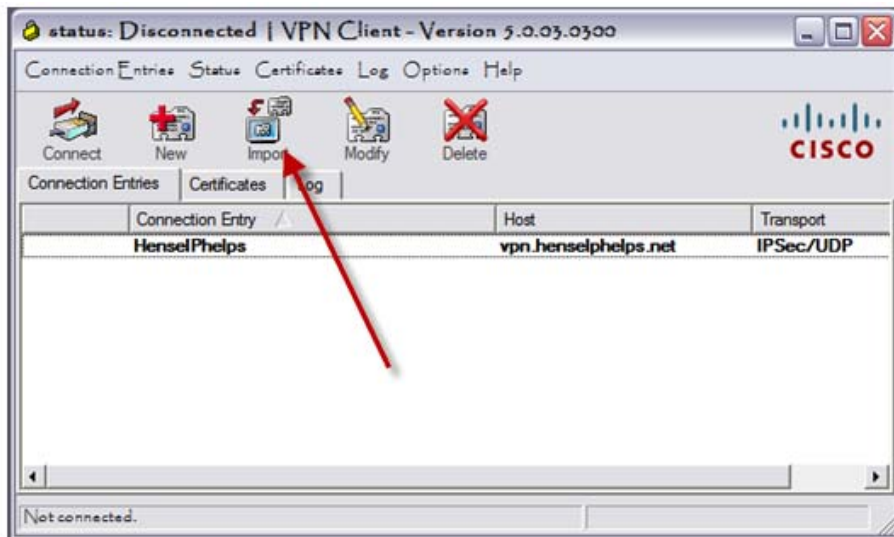




7. The next page will have a HenselPhelps VPN connection, however this VPN connection will not allow any users on the Courthouse to gain access, therefore you will need to import the Courthouse Settings in the next step.

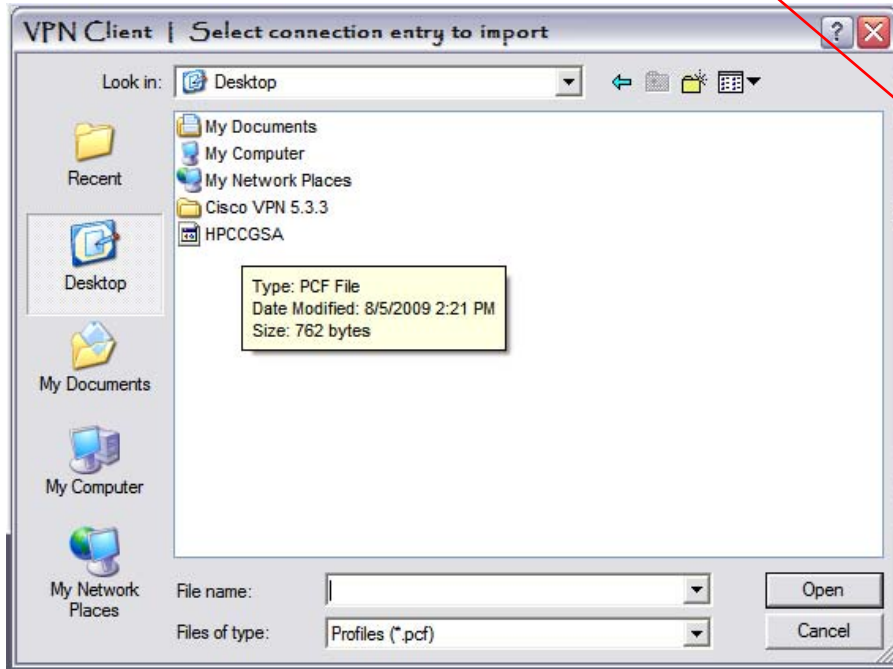


8. The next step is to click on the Import button on the VPN Client.



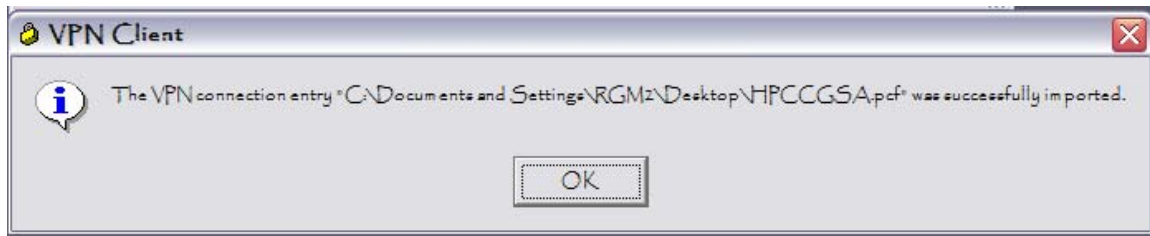


9. In this step you will need to browse to the HPCCGSA.pcf file located on your Desktop. Click on this file and click Open.



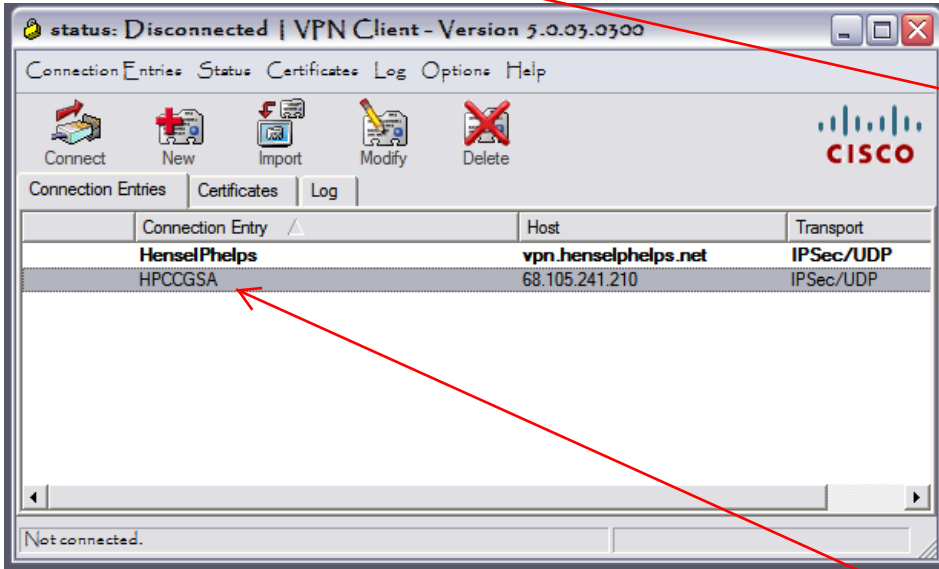

10. You will see the below box where the file has been successfully imported.



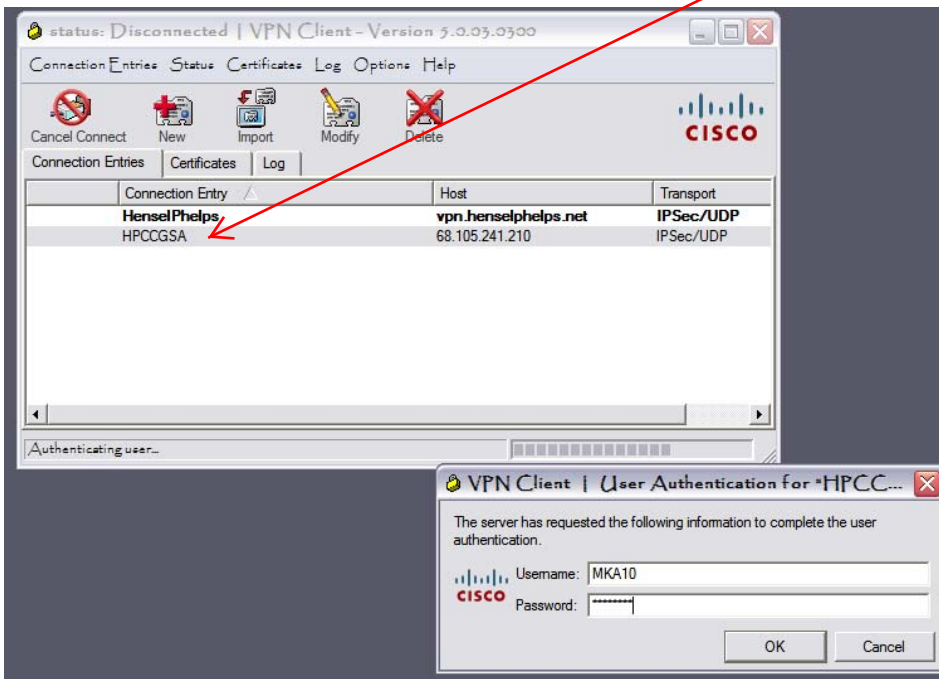


11. The HPCCGSA Connection Entry will appear in your VPN Client.

12. Once you double click on the HPCCGSA a Login box will appear. Your login information is located on the letter you received from Hensel Phelps.



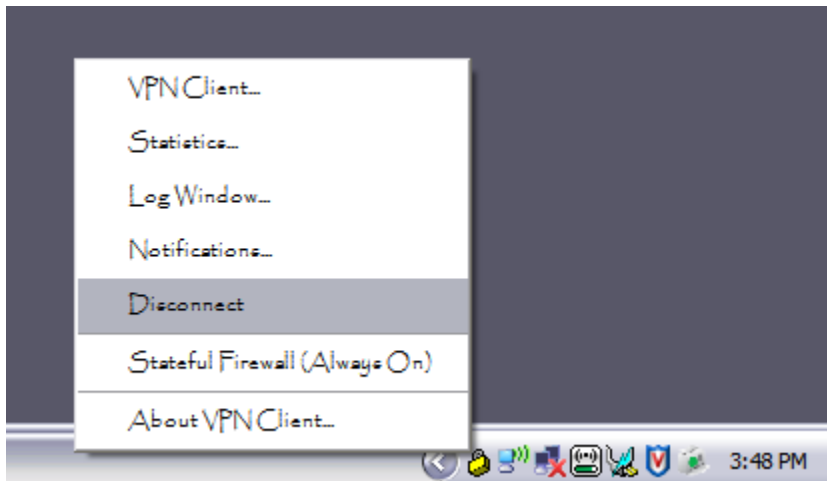

13. The VPN Client and Login page will disappear and in the Task Bar you will see a Pad Lock icon that is closed.



14. Once you have completed your downloading and uploading (in another tutorial) please Disconnect from the VPN Client by right clicking on the Pad Lock icon.



15. The Pad lock will appear unlock when you are Disconnected.
